A - God created us male and female in his own image to glorify him. (Genesis 1:27) Week 2 - Q - What else did God create? 2. A – God created all things, and all his creation was very good. (Genesis 1:31) Week 3 - Q – What does it mean to be made in the image of God? 3. A – The image of God refers to the immaterial part of man, which sets him apart from the animals. (It is the likeness mentally, morally, and socially.) (Genesis 1:27; 9:6) Week 4 - Q – How did God create the universe? 4. A – God spoke it into existence out of nothing (<i>ex nihilo</i>).
